The Hospitality Food and Beverage Certificate will be a 1 semester (9 credit) program. Students will enroll in Prin. of Hospitality 109-101, Legal Aspects of Hospitality 109-107, Sanitation, and the four-week Hygiene 316-170 (1 credit) course. The students will also complete the Responsible Beverage 311-400 course (4 hour) required for bartenders, servers, etc. Students will concurrently, or upon completion of course work, complete the 96 hour Conference Center Internship 109-145.

- Credit courses listed below can also be applied toward the Hotel/Hospitality Management Associate Degree program.
- All courses must have been taken in the last 10 years.
