- This certificate teaches students to expedite and route movement of incoming and outgoing cargo and freight shipments primarily in trucking terminals, and shipping docks. The student will learn to take orders from customers and arrange pickup of freight and cargo for delivery to loading platform. The student will prepare and examine bills of lading to determine shipping charges and tariffs.
- This certificate is designed for incumbent workers who may already be employed in the transportation industry and are interested in transitioning into a position of oversight and direct contact w/ freight transportation.
