ALCOHOL & OTHER DRUG ABUSE (AODA)
CERTIFICATE

24 Credits

- The AODA certificate is a series of eight courses which meet the educational requirements of the Wisconsin Certification Board (WCB). With appropriate work hours, students can become a Certified Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Counselor (CAD II or III).
All courses may be applied toward the Human Services Associate Degree.
Occupations for certificate graduates: AODA Counselor (Anticipated Wage Range: \$12-\$14/hr).
Certification available to certificate holders: CADC II or CADC III.

REQUIRED COURSES

Table with 4 columns: Course Number, Course Title, Credits, Term. Lists 8 required courses for the AODA certificate, including Interviewing Principles/Recordkeeping, Professional Practices in Human Services, AODA/Drug Abuse Rehabilitation, Counseling/Introduction to, Group Counseling, Psychopharmacology, Family and Chemical Abuse, and Mental Health and Substance Abuse. Total credits: 24.

NOTE: Students must complete a certificate program with a minimum of a 2.0 Program GPA.
NOTE: Prerequisites can be waived with departmental approval.
