GENERAL STUDIES TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

(Gateway Technical College to the University of Wisconsin Parkside)

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30 Credits Required for Certificate

- Courses can be applied toward general studies at the University of Wisconsin Parkside (UW-P)
- Courses can be applied toward a technical diploma and/or associate degree at Gateway Technical College (GTC)
- Students would be required to meet UW Parkside transfer criteria
- Courses may have prerequisites not listed below. Check the course catalogue for details.

Description

The General Studies Transfer Certificate allows students to complete 30 general studies courses at Gateway Technical College (GTC) that will transfer to the University of Wisconsin Parkside (UW-P). Students would be required to meet the UW-P transfer criteria. Once 15 credits have been earned with a 2.0 GPA, students can apply to UW-P for transfer.

Requirements for Certificate Entry

- GTC application and/or program add form
- An official high school diploma or equivalent
- ACT or SAT or GTC placement testing (writing, reading, pre-algebra, and algebra) if applicable
- Official college transcripts if applicable (students submitting official college transcripts to GTC will also need to submit transcripts to UW-P if requested)

Financial Aid

Apply for financial aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Please note that students must be accepted to a Gateway Associate Degree and/or Technical Diploma program to be considered for Financial Aid eligibility. Acceptance to this or any Internal Certificate program does not make the student eligible for Financial Aid.
