- It will be held 6 p.m. Feb. 26 in the Racine Building of the Racine Campus, 1001 S. Main St.

College Goal Wisconsin is an event designed to be an approachable way of learning how to apply for financial aid and get individual assistance in completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the federally required form for students seeking financial aid such as grants and loans. Students and parents are encouraged to attend together, where needed.

Things to bring:

- Social Security card
- Driver's license (if any)
- 2013 federal tax returns
- 2012 federal tax returns (if 2013 is incomplete)
- 2013 untaxed income records (Social Security, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, welfare or veterans benefits records)
- 2013 bank statements
- 2013 business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, and stock, bond, and other investment records
- Alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)

All students are eligible to apply for financial aid. Financial aid may come in

the form of grants, loans, work study, and other assistance.
