## Deadline nears for districtwide high school graduate scholarship application

The deadline is nearing for area graduating high school seniors to apply for a Gateway Technical College Foundation scholarship which would award them at least \$500 toward their education at the college.

One example of a Foundation scholarship is the President's Opportunity Scholarship, awarded to one graduate per high school in the Gateway District, which includes high schools in Kenosha, Racine, and Walworth counties. Students must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0 to apply.
