Set your Goals for Success!

Let's begin by looking at the end! Why? Knowing what you're aiming for is an important part of success! This helps us keep our focus and take the appropriate steps in the right direction.

Knowing what you value and desire, along with an assessment of your strengths, makes it possible to establish personal goals each semester. Your TRiO Specialist will help you record these goals on your **Student Success Plan**. Most people already have a mix of short-term and long-term goals in mind for themselves. Students are often aiming towards a particular test, project, class, grade point, degree or career. These are often complemented by other goals such as living a healthy life-style, work and nurturing relationships. It is not unusual for short-term goals to support long-

term goals. For example, a student's long term goal to be an accountant might be supported by a series of short-term goals related to class attendance, study habits, project preparation, and test performance. All goals, whether short-term or long-term, should incorporate these common attributes:

- **Realistic:** Goals should be based on abilities

and circumstances

- **Flexible:** Anticipate bumps in the road and be prepared to work around them
- **Measurable:** Have a target in mind so you know when you've reached your goal
- **Control:** Create goals in which you can control the outcome

rific **college success tools** and **ideas!** Please join us as we get ready for a great Fall Semester!

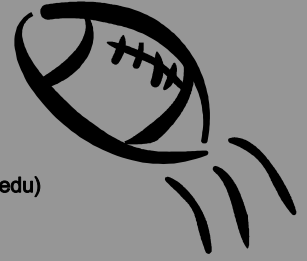
