- Know withdrawal deadlines (to withdraw from a course you may go to any Student Services Center and complete a withdrawal form; you may want to meet with your academic advisor to see if there are any ramifications for withdrawing from the course)
- Identify your registration date (this can be found on WebAdvisor)
- Schedule an appointment with your academic advisor
- Print out your academic evaluation (this can be found on WebAdvisor)
- Participate in class and keep an open communication with your instructors
- Maintain your academic program GPA requirements
- Make sure you are aware of your final exam schedule
- Utilize student success services and student organizations
- Learn about the student resources that are available to you (e.g. tutoring, student success center, library, and more)
- Follow all financial aid requirements
- Learn about paying for your tuition
- Always ask your advisor for assistance when needed
- Follow your academic plan
- Meet with your academic advisor regularly to ensure you are on your way to success!
