



## Advanced Placement (AP) Exams accepted at Gateway Technical College

### To receive proficiency college credit:

1. Students must be accepted into an associate's degree, technical diploma, certificate, or apprenticeship program at Gateway.
2. Submit official (unopened) AP test scores directly from CollegeBoard to Gateway Technical College.
3. A minimum score of three is required on all accepted AP exams listed below.

Gateway accepts all AP exams with a score of three or better. For all other AP exams offered but not listed in the table below with a direct equivalent Gateway course, three associate degree level elective credits - 890-991/2/3 will be awarded, which can fulfill required program elective credits.
