Eligibility and Application Information

What is the Denmark Vet Tech Global Scholar program?

This program has been designed to give students a look into veterinary education and animal care in Denmark, learn about animal care on non-traditional species, develop interpersonal skills, promote independence, and learn cultural connection and awareness for their future. We have planned each part of this program to give our students an experience they will never forget, while focusing on education, career development, culture, and personal growth.

Students will begin the program by flying to Copenhagen, Denmark. After arrival in Denmark, students will spend five days visiting the world class veterinary school at Copenhagen University, going to the Copenhagen zoo, The Blue Planet Aquarium, and taking in the culture of Copenhagen by visiting landmarks and museums all over the city. After that, students will travel by train to Ebeltoft, Denmark. They will spend the day at the Ree Safari Park. The next day, students will head back to Copenhagen, Denmark by train. Students will have a day in Copenhagen to explore before returning home.

To be eligible to apply to this program you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be declared in the Vet Tech Program
- Completed 6 credits
- Have a program GPA of 2.5 or better
- Be able to provide two (2) recommendations from Gateway faculty members
- Be available to interview in November
- Attend orientation in December
- Be in compliance with department and college policies
- Must have or be able to obtain a valid U.S. Passport by January/February 2023

Successful candidates will work well in a team environment, have the social maturity to represent the U.S. and Gateway abroad, and be able to meet deadlines.

If selected to participate you will be required to:

- Register for and successfully complete International Field Study course
- Meet all deadlines including payment deadlines

- Participate in MANDATORY pre and post departure activities including MANDATORY Orientations
- Submit a signed Publicity Release Form
- Submit a completed Medical/Emergency Information form. We reserve the right to request additional health information from you and/or a statement from your health care provider verifying your health prior to departure
- Submit a copy of the front page of your passport
- Keep your student account current
- Meet program requirements and comply with any applicable rule, code of conduct, regulation, instruction or law during the program. Noncompliance may result in expulsion from the program, forfeiture of fees, and being immediately <u>sent home at your expense</u>

Fee payment schedule

- \$80.00 paid at orientation
- Refundable if not approved for the program but otherwise non-refundable
- Course tuition and program fees paid to Gateway and subject to the same payment and refund policies as other Gateway courses. See your student handbook or Student Services Center for further information
- Student account must be current prior to departure

Participants who drop from the program will be held responsible for any unrecoverable fees incurred by Gateway Technical College.
