Eligibility and Application Information

Tentative Travel Dates: April/May 2022 (Dates are subject to change) **Description**

Participants will visit Both Costa Rica and Panama and participate in service-learning projects in their specific program areas. Students will work side-by-side with Doctors and nurses in hospitals and clinics, schools, and also perform educational healthcare home visits. This multi-disciplinary project will actively engage students in projects teaching them to problem solve in a variety of international cultural situations. Recreational opportunities include beaches, zip lining, and rafting. Open to Nursing, Physical Therapy, Early Childhood, Vet Tech, and Dental Assistant students.

To be eligible you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be in compliance with department and college policies and free of disciplinary action or progressive disciplinary action
- Have or be able to obtain a valid U.S. Passport

Successful candidates should have the social maturity to represent the U.S. and Gateway Technical College abroad with dignity, respect, and accountability for one's actions, work well in a team setting, and to be able to handle uncertainty with maturity.

Additional eligibility requirements for STUDENTS:

- Be declared in the Nursing, Physical Therapy, Early Childhood, Vet Tech, or Dental Assistant Program.
- Have completed 6 credits
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4-point scale) in declared program
- Be able to provide two (2) letters of recommendation from Gateway faculty
- Be available for an interview in November 2021
- Attend orientation December 2021

If selected to participate you will be required to:

- Register for and successfully complete course Serving to Learn Globally Course (2 credits) and Cultural Elements of Study abroad (1 credit).
- Meet all deadlines including payment deadlines.
- Participate in <u>MANDATORY</u> pre and post departure activities including <u>MANDATORY Orientations</u>.
- Submit a signed Publicity Release form.
- Submit a completed Medical/Emergency Information form.

- We reserve the right to request additional health information from you and/or a statement from your health care provider verifying your health prior to departure.
- Submit a copy of the front page of your passport.
- Meet program requirements and comply with any applicable rule, code of conduct, regulation, Instruction or law during the program. Noncompliance may result in expulsion from the program, Forfeiture of fees, and being immediately sent home at your expense.

- Student account must be current prior to departure.
