Contract For Service: A closed section reserved for the high school students. Students take classes at their high school or at Gateway with a Gateway instructor. Students earn both high school and college credit at the same time.

Transcribed Credit: The high school teacher is certified by Gateway to teach Gateway's curriculum at the high school. Students earn both high school and college credit at the same time.

Advanced Standing: Students earn Gateway credit only if the student earns a B or better, enrolls at Gateway within 27 months & has a valid agreement in place.

VanGuard: *Virtual learning. Students take courses at their high school using VanGuard equipment to virtually learn with their Gateway instructor. Student earns both high school and college credit at the same time.*
