As a professional you have already learned to use the tools of your trade. This course will give you an opportunity to learn how you can share that knowledge with others in your field.

In this workshop you will:

- Understand your role as a job site trainer.
- Learn how to be a coach and mentor.
- Discover how to maintain a positive work environment.
- Examine the process for giving useful feedback.
- Build a training tool-kit to take back to your job.

Apprenticeship training is a collaborative partnership: employer and employee associations, government, and educational institutions each play a part. In reality, most learning takes place through the daily interaction between an apprentice and his/her co-workers.

Transition-to-Trainer is a course that was developed by and for Wisconsin's apprenticeship community to develop journey level worker's and supervisor's ability to pass on their knowledge of the trade.

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
