Awards: Attendance at the Women in Aviation International in Lake Buena Vista, FL \$2,000*: Support includes transportation, lodging, meals, and registration March 5-7, 2020 * Subject to availability of funds.

Purpose: Scholarships to support two outstanding female undergraduate students interested in aviation-related careers.

To Apply:

- Register on the WSGC website (<u>https://spacegrant.carthage.edu/forms/account/login).</u> Applicants will be prompted to update personal information annually.
- Upload current resume to applicant profile. WSGC will share the provided resume with Wisconsin Aerospace Industry partners for co-op, internship, and employment opportunities if applicant grants WSGC permission by marking the check box provided.
- <u>Sign in</u> and submit the <u>Grant Application Form</u> (applicants may apply to multiple funding programs) and supporting documents.

Application Requirements: Applicants who meet the following requirements can apply for this scholarship by registering and applying online at <u>spacegrant.carthage.edu/about/login</u>:

- U.S. citizen
- WI resident during academic year
- Enrolled full-time in, admitted to, or applied to any undergraduate program at a <u>WSGC college or</u> <u>university</u>
- Minimum 3.0 GPA (*Proposals that include a GPA of less than 3.0 will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis*)
- Completed application online (see Supporting Materials Required with Application below)

Award winners will be chosen based on academic performance, aerospace-related promise, and the demonstrated interest in pursuing a career in STEM/aerospace/aviation. For consideration, the application form must be complete and be accompanied by supporting documentation.

Supporting Materials Required with Application:

1. Maximum two-page statement containing the following (See <u>Tools & Tips</u> for more information on how to create professional communications):

- a. Interest in aviation.
- b. Experience in aviation (coursework, pilot training, etc.).
- c. Benefit of attending the 2020 Women in Aviation conference.
- d. Future plan to participate in aviation as a career, hobby, etc.
- 2. Copy of most recent college transcript (unofficial is acceptable/not required for incoming freshmen)
- 3. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation: Letter(s) of recommendation may be submitted with the online application. Confidential letter(s) of recommendation may be emailed to <u>spacegrant@carthage.edu</u>. Subject: WAI20_LOR.
 - a. One from a faculty member who advises the applicant
 - b. One from an aviation mentor.

***NOTE:** Students also applying for the Undergraduate Research Fellowship or other Undergraduate Scholarship Program should submit a statement distinguishing the scholarship from the fellowship application. Primary consideration for Women in Aviation Scholarship awardees is given to first-time applicants.
