The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, University of Wisconsin-Whitewater at Rock County and the Wisconsin Technical Colleges System are committed to collaborate to create a pathway that will enhance the access of Foundation of Teacher Education (FOTE) students around the state to course work for licensure as Elementary/Middle School Teachers.

This articulation provides a fully online program wherein students can (a) have all the credits from their FOTE degree applied towards Bachelor of Applied Arts and Science (BAAS) degree completion (b) take courses work preparing students for Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction licensure to teach Kindergarten-9th grade.

Benefits of the articulation:

- There is a “[severe teacher shortage](#)” in the state (and [this](#)). This articulation allows students to complete the degree and apply for licensure.
- UW-Whitewater graduates the most licensed teachers in the state of Wisconsin. UW-Whitewater is renowned in the state for the quality of its education majors.
- Currently there is no efficient pathway for FOTE students to receive licensure. This articulation addresses this gap.
- UW-Whitewater at Rock County’s BAAS is delivered fully online allowing access for students from all parts of the state of Wisconsin
- BAAS accepts and applies the entire FOTE degree leaving student with about 60 credits to degree completion
- Wisconsin residents are able to take courses at in-state tuition rate (based on in-state rate for campus/program)

This articulation agreement establishes a cooperative relationship between the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater (UW-Whitewater) and Wisconsin Technical College System effective for students starting the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) in or after the fall 2025 term, which will assist both to better serve the educational needs of transfer students.

This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the guidelines set forth in the University of Wisconsin System Administrative Policy 140, Guidelines for Articulation Agreements between UW System Institutions and WTCS Districts as well as Administrative Policy 135 Undergraduate Transfer Policy. Both institutions agree to maintain accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission and any other accreditation currently in existence pertaining to degree programs articulated via the transfer agreement.

Purpose of Articulation Agreement

This program-to-program articulation agreement between UW-Whitewater and Wisconsin Technical College System allows students to be awarded up to **65** credits toward the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences Education emphasis, if they meet the following criteria:

1. successfully complete the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.)-Foundations of Teacher Education at any Wisconsin Technical College offering this degree.
2. earn a cumulative GPA of a 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale), including coursework from other institutions (if appropriate), and according to UW-W repeat policy: <https://www.uww.edu/registrar/policies#repeats>
3. have applied to and are successfully admitted into UW-Whitewater (all UW-Whitewater application deadlines apply) beginning fall 2025 and any subsequent terms: <https://www.uww.edu/admissions/transfer>
4. declare the Bachelor Applied Arts and Sciences major with Education emphasis at time of admission/upon transfer to UW-Whitewater.

Courses and Requirements

1. Once students are admitted they will be required to meet the criteria for graduation and recommendation for licensure outlined in Section C as well as UW-Whitewater's Associate of Arts and Sciences and BAAS degree requirements.
 - 1.1. Students must earn a 2.75 Combined Cumulative GPA before student teaching and before graduation.
 - 1.2. Students must earn a 3.0 in their Content Courses or pass the Praxis II with qualifying scores.
 - 1.3. Students must complete BAAS-Education specific Coursework in section C
2. Elective courses taken or substituted at the sending institution and sending program not listed in this agreement will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they may apply to the degree at the receiving institution.
3. Entering students may apply general education credits toward satisfying UW-Whitewater general education requirements as specified in Transferology: <https://www.transferology.com/school/uww>
4. The specific WTCS courses that will satisfy the UW-W general education requirements will be determined using guidance provided by the Universal Credit Transfer Agreement (UCTA).
5. Regardless of major, a minimum of 25% of the major course units and 25% of the minor course units must be completed at UW-Whitewater.
6. A minimum of 30 units of UW-Whitewater coursework is required to qualify for an undergraduate degree.
 - 6.1. At least 15 of these 30 units must be taken at UW-Whitewater immediately prior to graduation
7. The maximum number of credits that can be transferred from all two-year transfer institutions to UW-W is 72.

Additional Conditions

1. Program-to-program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the major/emphasis combination specified in this agreement. A change of major and/or emphasis invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other program-to-program articulation agreement for a different major at UW-Whitewater.
2. Course equivalencies specified in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the course curricula of relevant programs at Wisconsin Technical Colleges or at UW-Whitewater undergo revision.
3. For students admitted from Wisconsin Technical Colleges with a completed Foundations of Teacher Education degree, the degree must be posted on an official transcript to receive credits from the agreement.
4. This Articulation Agreement is effective fall 2025 and shall remain in effect for five years, unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
5. UW-Whitewater and Wisconsin Technical Colleges agree to assist each other in appropriately promoting this agreement in their respective marketing materials, events, websites, and reports.


