Certificate: INFANT/TODDLER CREDENTIAL (90-307-2)

Credits: 12 Credits

Description: This series of courses is designed for early care and education providers who work with children under the age of three. This includes infant toddler teachers, assistant teachers, program directors and administrators. Students taking these courses will gain understanding of developmental stages for this age group while learning how to best guide and nurture children under the age of three in both center-based and family settings. After completion of this internal certificate, eligible students may register to commission with THE REGISTRY to earn the Infant Toddler Credential. Potential Jobs for completers include infant/toddler teacher or assistant teacher.
