ADMINISTRATOR'S CREDENTIAL CERTIFICATE (90-307-7)

18 Credits

These courses are designed to train administrators and program directors of early childhood care and education programs. Additionally, they will train new leadership for early childhood programs by preparing childcare staff to assume increased responsibility and to provide orientation for others from related professions who wish to work in early childhood programs. After completion of Gateway's Internal Certificate – "Administrator's Credential", the student must follow certain procedures as outlined by The Registry in order to receive this credential.
