**Certificate:** **ALCOHOL & OTHER DRUG ABUSE (AODA) (90-550-1)**

**Credits:** **24 Credits**

**Description:** This certificate is a series of eight courses which meet the educational requirements of the Department of Regulation & Licensing (DRL). With appropriate work hours, students can become a Substance Abuse Counselor (SAC). With appropriate work hours and a Human Services degree students can become a Clinical Substance Abuse Counselor (CSAC). All courses may be applied toward the Human Services Associate Degree.

Occupations for certificate graduates: AODA Counselor (Anticipated Wage Range: \$12-\$14/hr). Certification available to certificate holders: SAC and CSAC.
