#### 30 Credits Required for Certificate

#### Description

The General Studies Transfer Certificate allows students to complete 30 general studies credits at Gateway Technical College (Gateway) that will transfer to the University of Wisconsin-Parkside (UW-P). Students are required to meet the UW-P transfer criteria.

#### **Requirements for Certificate Entry**

- WTCS Application for Admission and/or program add form
- Official high school, GED, or HSED transcript, including a graduation or passing date
- ACT or SAT or Gateway placement assessments (writing, reading, math, and computer skills) if applicable
- Official college transcripts from all previously attended colleges/universities, if applicable
- Gateway & UW-Parkside 1+3 Consortium Agreement Form
- Gateway & UW-Parkside 1+3 Statement of Educational Intent Form
- 2.0 cumulative GPA or Advisor Consent

#### Financial Aid

Students in this certificate will be dually admitted at Gateway and UW-Parkside. Students may be eligible for federal financial aid through UW-Parkside. Apply for financial aid at <a href="www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a> using UW-P school code 005015. Students should meet with their Gateway Academic Advisor to complete the UW-Parkside Advance Approval for Proposed Transfer Credits form and develop an academic plan.
