Description: This certificate provides students with a working knowledge of Spanish: the ability to comprehend, read, write, and speak Spanish at least at the intermediate level. It includes vocabulary, grammar, and techniques specific to the healthcare field. The certificate includes extensive study of the cultural competencies necessary to deliver more effective healthcare to the Spanish-speaking population and will help develop the student into a culturally competent caregiver. Being proficient in Spanish makes students more valuable to employers and can distinguish them from otherwise equally qualified applicants for a job or promotion.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in these courses to obtain the certificate.

Students with prior experience in Spanish can test out of some of the courses by taking an exam administered through Gateway's Credit for Prior Learning process. However, students must take at least 802-119 Spanish III or 802-118 Spanish IV AND and 802-126 Spanish for Healthcare Providers at Gateway in order to qualify for the certificate.

NOTE: Students must complete a certificate program with a minimum of a 2.0 Program GPA.
