Certificate: ADMINISTRATOR'S CREDENTIAL (90-307-7)

Credits: 18 Credits

Description: These courses are designed for administrators and directors of early care and education programs who wish to increase or refine existing skills, add new competencies OR earn a professional credential. These courses are critical to those working in ECE programs who wish to learn more about administration or maximize their business knowledge. These courses are also designed to prepare staff in non-administrative positions to take on new leadership roles and increased responsibility. After completion of this internal certificate, eligible students may register to commission with THE REGISTRY to earn the Administrator Credential. Potential Jobs for completers include administrator or program director of early childhood care and education programs.
