Certificate: NAIL TECHNICIAN (90-502-1)

Credits: 9 Credits

Description: This certificate provides instruction in basic and advanced nail techniques including application of acrylic, fiberglass, silk, and gel nails. Courses are theory, practical, and client services centered, and allow students to prepare for the Wisconsin State Board Exam. There is a separate kit required for each course.
