Certificate: **MEDICATION ASSISTANT (90-543-2)**

Credits: **3 Credits**

Description: Medication Assistants are Certified Nursing Assistants who have completed an approved training program and have received additional certification to administer medications and perform nonsterile treatments in a Skilled Nursing Facility in Wisconsin, following the policies and procedures of their organization. They perform the delegated function of medication administration under the supervision of a registered nurse. Routes of administration include oral, topical, eye, ear, and nose drops; vaginal; rectal; transdermal; and oral inhalers.
