Certificate: RETAIL BEAUTY ADVISOR (61-502-1)

Credits: 4 Credits

**Description:** The Retail Beauty Advisor Certificate is designed to prepare students for

entry level positions as a retail beauty consultant/advisor. This course includes theory and practical training in facial massage, skin care, basic and corrective makeup application, eyebrow arching, waxing, and seasonal color analysis and is designed to help the student understand business principles, customer service, salesmanship, and philosophy of

business objectives for salons.
