Certificate: SPANISH PROFICIENCY (90-802-1)

Credits: 16 Credits

Description: This certificate provides students with a working knowledge of Spanish: the ability to comprehend, read, write, and speak Spanish at least at the intermediate level. The certificate includes extensive study of intermediate vocabulary and grammatical structures as well as cultural studies of both Spain and Latin America. Being proficient in Spanish makes students more valuable to employers and can distinguish them from otherwise equally qualified applicants for a job or promotion.
