WGTD presents The Kat Trio encore performances

WGTD radio will co-sponsor encore miniperformances of The Kat Trio, a Russian violin-clarinet-piano ensemble, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. August 4 at Kenosha Harbor Market, located on 2nd Ave. in Kenosha's Harbor Park.

The violin-clarinet-piano ensemble from Ekaterinburg, Russia, formed in 1998 by three friends – Victoria Gorbich (violin), Vladislav Gorbich (clarinet) and Vasil Galiulin (piano) – who had just graduated from the Ural State Music Conservatory.

Today, "The Kat Trio" is comprised of Victoria Gorbich,
Vladislav Gorbich and Julie Page, touring as artists-inresidence with Wisconsin Public Radio and the Chazen
Museum of Art. Victoria Gorbich and Vladislav Gorbich are
doctoral graduates of Arizona State University. Page, the

newest member of the trio, is a doctoral candidate at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

WGTD is presenting the performances along with Wisconsin Public Radio. The trio performed earlier this year at Kenosha Winter Harbor Market.

The three are on the road presenting their Russian arrangements and transpositions of timeless melodies. The Trio's concerts feature classical works, well-known inspirational songs, and even American pop standards, including Scott Joplin's ragtime melodies.

The Kat Trio has played more than 500 concerts across the United States. When not found in concert venues, college or high school auditoriums, or in classrooms conducting master's-level courses, the Trio is performing for Sunday services or presenting concerts in churches.
