Gateway receives grant to expand emergency alert system

District Mutual Insurance awarded Gateway Technical College \$27,000 as

part of a risk management project award to expand the college's current

notification system within its facilities throughout the district.

The municipal mutual insurance company, founded by the Wisconsin

Technical College System, at its July 24 quarterly meeting awarded \$440,000 in

risk management project awards to colleges throughout the system.

Gateway's award includes paying for and installing horns and LED

message boards districtwide which would allow a greater number of students,

staff and community visitors to see and hear the college's emergency alarms.

These elements would be installed into the present emergency Alertus

System and expand the notification environment currently available within

Gateway facilities.
