Capelli to keynote Gateway Fall 2013 graduation ceremony

Kenosha physician AJ Capelli, of Aurora Medical Center, will deliver the keynote address of Gateway Technical College's associate degree and technical diploma fall and summer commencement ceremony Dec. 19.

The ceremony will recognize 457 prospective candidates for graduation. A total of 196 have registered to participate in the ceremony.

The ceremony will be held 6 p.m. in the Indian Trail High School Auditorium, 6800 60th St., Kenosha.

Bryan Albrecht, Gateway president, will deliver the welcome address. Albrecht and members of the Gateway Technical College Board of Trustees will present degrees; Heather Bennett, graduate in Gateway's Human Services program, will provide the student response; and faculty member Ginger Karaway will lead the ceremony opening and closing.

Dr. Capelli is the president/vice president/committee member with the medical executive committee at Aurora Medical Center, a position he's held since 1998. He also is the medical director and on the medical executive committee for the Aurora Medical Group in Kenosha, a position he's held since 1994. He was also the medical director of quality/care management for Aurora Health Care-

South Region from 1999-2004, and served as the Kenosha Medical Director to

the Aurora/Compcare Health Network.
