Gateway students to receive in-demand training for Kubota equipment

Gateway Technical College students will soon gain the skills and certifications to work on Kubota equipment and help meet the increasing demand for qualified, early career technicians who can work on the heavy equipment at dealerships and other businesses.

Diesel students will begin gaining those starting in the Spring 2019 semester.
