Gateway designated as "Military Friendly School" by national group for fourth straight year

For the fourth straight year, Victory Media, the premier publisher of magazines for military personnel transitioning into civilian life, has designated Gateway Technical College to its list of Military Friendly Schools.

The 2015 Military Friendly Schools list honors the top 15 percent of colleges and universities which are doing the most to embrace America's military service members, veterans and their spouses to ensure their success as students.
