Gateway designated as “Military Friendly School” by national group fifth straight year

For the fifth straight year, Victory Media, the premier publisher of magazines for military personnel transitioning into civilian life, has awarded Gateway Technical College the designation of Military Friendly School.

The 2016 Military Friendly Schools ratings recognize colleges and companies with leading programs for veterans, members of the Armed Forces leaving military service and military spouses.

The survey weighting, methodology and list were independently certified by Ernst and Young.
