Nomination deadline extended for Gateway's Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award

Gateway Technical College has extended the deadline to submit nominations for the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award to December 31.

Honorees will be recognized at Gateway Technical College's 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration program at noon January 21, 2013.
