



Gateway Technical College introduces the Gateway Promise.

The Gateway Promise ensures Kenosha, Racine and Walworth County high school graduates who meet program eligibility can attend college tuition-free (students are responsible for costs of books and course materials not covered by financial aid).

The Gateway Promise will help tri-county area high school students realize their dreams of attending college and preparing for a career. Southeast Wisconsin employers will benefit from access to an increased pipeline of highly qualified employees with education and training essential for regional economic growth and prosperity.

WHAT IS THE GATEWAY PROMISE?

The Gateway Promise will ensure every qualifying student in the Gateway District has the opportunity to graduate with a college degree from Gateway Technical College. With generous community support through the Gateway Technical College Foundation, the cost of tuition and fees will be covered for the student.

Books and supplies are the responsibility of the student.

- ✓ Support is calculated after federal and state grants are applied, but before loans, federal work study, and non-tuition scholarships.
- ✓ Funding will be available to the Gateway Promise student for six semesters – two per academic year – up to 18 credits each semester (\$10,500 total).

The Gateway Promise student must continue to be successful throughout those six semesters to remain eligible by maintaining the 12-credit or more full-time status, a 2.0 program grade point average (GPA) and by participating in academic planning, career and other workshops.

Participation in learning enhancement activities such as service learning, international education, student clubs and more will be required.

Promise students begin their Gateway experience with a MANDATORY "Promise Kickoff" and "Promise Scholars" summer college readiness program that introduces them to Gateway's many services, opportunities, academic preparation and fun student life activities.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE GATEWAY PROMISE?

Students must meet these requirements to be eligible for the Gateway Promise.

- ✓ On time graduation OR submit Letter of Explanation from an official high school administrator verifying your graduation status
- ✓ Graduate from a Gateway District high school or resident of the Gateway District
- ✓ Be a U.S. citizen, a national or a permanent resident of the United States (Note: Students who do not fall into one of these categories cannot receive Financial Aid)
- ✓ Apply for admission by March 1 of senior year
- ✓ Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 1 of senior year
- ✓ Achieve a cumulative 2.0 GPA at the time of application for admission (Note: Admissions application deadline is March 1 of senior year)
- ✓ Chosen program of study must meet federal and state financial aid eligibility requirements
- ✓ ACT Composite 16 or higher OR Accuplacer Reading, Writing and Math scores of 237 or higher
- ✓ Expected Family Contribution (EFC) must be \$3,000 or lower (as calculated from the FAFSA)
- ✓ Enroll as a full-time student at Gateway for the fall immediately following senior year
- ✓ Attend the mandatory Promise Kickoff and Promise Scholars summer college readiness program
