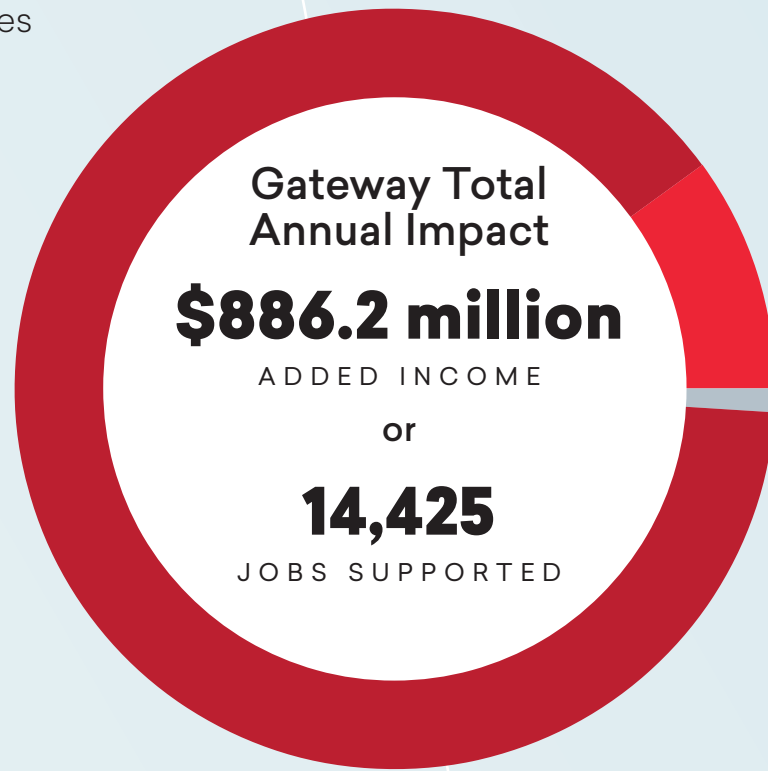

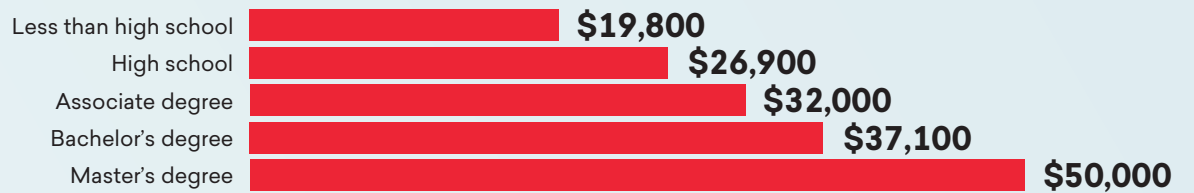

STUDENTS
