



Gateway Technical College International Student Admissions Checklist

- Complete the application** at <https://www.gtc.edu/admissions/audience/international-students>, and **pay the \$30 application fee**. For assistance with the application process, contact a New Student Specialist – a list is available at <https://www.gtc.edu/student-services/admissions/new-student>. - TOEFL Test** - Gateway Technical College's number is 1255 and requires a score of at least 180 (CBT) or 64 (IBT). Scores must be no older than 2 years. See www.ets.org/toefl for dates, locations, and information on how to sign up for testing. See <https://www.gtc.edu/student-services/admissions/toefl> for a list of exceptions regarding the TOEFL testing requirement.

- Foreign transcript evaluation by a Certified Credential Evaluation Service** – Contact information is available at <http://www.gtc.edu/student-services/admissions/transcript-translation-services>. A general evaluation is required for all applicants, unless official transcripts are submitted that show:
 - A degree (high school or higher) earned in the U.S. Or,
 - Admission to a UW system college undergraduate or graduate degree (Not ESL).If credits were earned at a higher education institution or university outside the U.S., a **Catalog Match Evaluation** is needed to award transfer equivalency credit.

- Certificate of Finances form** - Complete and submit along with supporting financial documentation. Must be able to verify sufficient funds available to cover the total cost of a full academic year of education **and** other expenses while in the U.S. You may use the Cost of Study Estimate for International Students along with the worksheet to help identify how you will pay for your education.

- International Student Questionnaire** which includes Emergency Contact information for a contact in both the United States **and** in your home country.

- Deposit of \$2400** - All first semester students are required to pay an initial down payment of \$2400. This payment can be made either from outside the U.S. or at Gateway Technical College during the orientation session.

- ACCUPLACER and computer skills assessment testing** – can be completed at mandatory orientation meeting.

- Transferring In** - If transferring from another college, you will also be required to complete an International Transfer form -<https://www.gtc.edu/admissions/audience/international-students/international-students-transferring-gateway>

Gateway Technical College offers three full-term sessions throughout the academic year. Students may attend, but are not required to attend all three full-length terms. If you plan to enroll for the summer term in addition to the academic year, additional tuition and course supplies funding should be budgeted.

- Tuition and fees are calculated based on twelve credits (full-time enrollment).
- Estimates for tuition, fees, books, and supplies may increase depending on your program and course selection.
- Tuition and fees will increase with additional courses and/or credits.
- Expenses for travel from and to your home country are not included.
- You must be able to show that you have \$17,500.00 for 1-year Technical Diploma.
- You must be able to show that you have \$17,500.00 (cost of one academic year) for 2-year Associate Degree.
- All first semester students are required to pay an initial down payment of \$2400. This payment can be made either from outside the U.S. or at Gateway Technical College during the orientation session.

To document that you have the funds needed for the total cost of your education, please:

1. Complete the Certification of Finances form.
2. Include documentation of the financial resources you will use to cover the total cost of your education at Gateway Technical College.
 - a. This may be bank statements no older than three months that have been certified/signed by a bank official.
 - b. If you are being sponsored, this may be letters confirming sponsorship with certified/signed bank statements no older than three months, verifying the sponsors' available funds.
