

What information is on the Form 1098-T?

Box 1: The total payments, including loans, from any source received by an eligible educational institution during the calendar year that paid for qualified tuition and related expenses less any reimbursements or refunds made during 2019 that relate to payments received during 2019. If you registered for and paid for Spring 2019 classes in calendar year of 2018, those payments will not be included in the 2019 Form 1098T.

Box 2: Reserved. Box 2 is blank because the IRS eliminated the option of reporting amounts billed. Starting with the 2018 tax year, schools have to report in Box 1 (payment received).

Box 3: Reserved. Box 3 is blank due to the IRS requiring all schools to report in Box 1, starting with the 2018 tax year.

Box 4: Shows any adjustment made by an eligible educational institution for a prior year for qualified tuition and related expenses that were reported on a prior year Form 1098T.

Box 5: Shows the total of all scholarships, grants, and third party payments administered and processed by the eligible educational institution. The amount for the calendar year (including those not reported by the institution) may reduce the amount of education credit you claim for the year.

Box 6: Shows adjustments to scholarships or grants for a prior year.

Box 7: Shows whether the amount in box 1 includes amounts for an academic period beginning January-March 2019.

Box 8: Shows whether you are considered to be carrying at least one-half the normal full-time workload for your course of study at the reporting institution.
