



Cosmetology & Barber Technologist Program Technical Standards

Students enrolled in the Cosmetology/Barber Program should be able to meet the established technical standards identified below. The technical standards for the Cosmetology/Barber Program are representative of those found in the Cosmetology/Barber profession.

Ability	Standard	Examples (not inclusive)
Physical	Student must have sufficient: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Endurance, strength, mobility, balance, flexibility and coordination to perform client haircare services and procedures • Gross and fine motor skills to perform varying haircare services in a timely, safe and effective manner 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stand with hands above shoulders, walk and maintain balance at varying intervals • Bend, stretch, squat, twist, kneel and reach • Good hand-eye coordination • Finger and manual dexterity (squeeze, grasp, twist, pinch, and manipulate small objects) • Comb hair and section/partings vertical partings, horizontal partings and diagonal partings • Cut hair using shears, razor, clipper
Sensory	Student must have sufficient: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Auditory ability • Visual ability • Sense of Smell • Tactile ability 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detect audible sounds for function and malfunction of equipment • Ability to visually detect tools & equipment displays • Ability to visually detect environmental hazards • Detect objects, symbols and numbers both near and far • Detect and identify different hair & product colors • Detect changes in skin (redness, bleeding, swelling) • Detect odors (chemical, alcohol, fire) • Detect subtle differences in hair & scalp (texture, density, porosity, abrasions)
Communication	Student must have effective: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verbal communication • Nonverbal communication 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ability to discuss and ask questions regarding client care with client. • Ability to convey information in a clear, professional and timely manner

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Written communication • Electronic communication <p>Student must be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interact appropriately with clients, peers and leadership • Interpret and convey information • Speak, read, write, comprehend, interpret, and document information • Recognize nonverbal behavior 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen and respond to others in an accepting and respectful manner • Discuss details and ask questions regarding client care • Listen and respond to others in a nonjudgmental, respectful manner • Awareness of non-verbal communication • Observe, interpret and respond appropriately to surroundings, nonverbal cues, verbal and written information
Safety	<p>Student must be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply knowledge, skills and experience to maintain a safe work environment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work in an environment with potentially hazardous materials • Tolerate exposure to allergens (products, chemicals, cleaning agents) • Demonstrate adherence to safety guidelines and regulations • Recognize potentially hazardous conditions and take appropriate actions • Utilize personal protective equipment (gloves, masks, eyewear, draping) • Operate tools & equipment, adhering to safety standards • Identify and resolve unsafe situations • Be familiar with and follow safety & disinfection procedures
Critical Thinking	<p>Student must have sufficient critical thinking and problem solving skills to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calculate, reason, analyze and synthesize data in a timely manner • Problem solve and make decisions in a timely professional manner • Adapt decisions based on new information 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply broad concepts to haircare services • Concentrate to perform client service tasks • Recognize the need to consult with clients • Demonstrate problem-solving skills • Problem solve complex situations while maintaining a professional demeanor • Anticipate client needs for procedures, and respond appropriately • Make decisions independently
