STUDENT AND EMPLOYEE ADVISORS

Student and employees who are either the reporting or responding party involved in a case with the Office for Equal Opportunity and Civil Right have a right to an advisor. An advisor can attend any meeting to provide support and assist a party through the equity resolution process. Students and employees can choose anyone to be their advisor, including a friend, family member, colleague, attorney, etc. Parties can also choose a trained provider to assist them with the equity resolution process. Trained advisors understand their role as an advisor, the resources available to parties, and can assist parties with navigating the process. Though employees of the college, trained advisors do not share any information with college officials or others involved in a case, with rare exception such as an ongoing danger to the college community.
