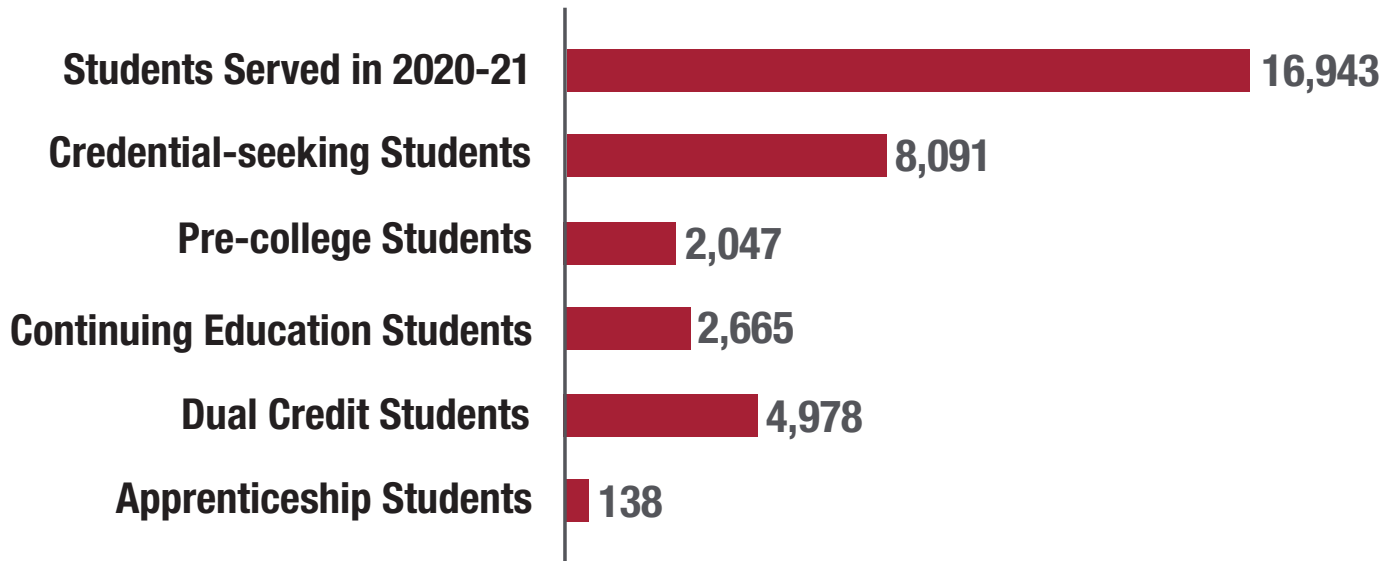

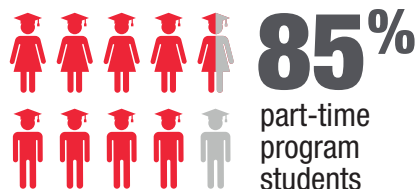
Together, our campus community persevered through the pandemic by creating new innovations & opportunities.




Serving Students by Meeting Them Where They Are
