



GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE VA EDUCATION BENEFIT CHECKLIST

If you are a veteran, or a spouse/dependent of a veteran, that would like to apply for VA Education Benefits at Gateway Technical College, please use this checklist as a guide to ensure all required documents are submitted.

ALL STUDENTS APPLYING FOR VA EDUCATION BENEFITS AT GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE

1. If you are unsure of which VA education benefit you are eligible for, please contact the County Veteran Service Office (see VA Resources below). They will be able assist you with the application process and determine which benefit you are eligible for.
2. Once you know which VA education benefit you are eligible for, schedule an initial consultation with a Student Finance Specialist by calling 1-800-247-7122, emailing veterans@gtc.edu, or by visiting any Student Services Center (Racine, Kenosha, or Elkhorn). Use the checklist on side 2 of this document as a guide as to what documentation you need to bring to your appointment.
3. Complete your Gateway [VA-Education Benefit Request Form \(VA-EBRF\)](#) at least 2 business days prior to registering for classes every semester you would like to use benefits. You can access this form by going to: [Veteran Education Benefit Forms](#). Login with your [MyGateway](#) student id# and password.
4. Veterans may be eligible to receive transfer credit for military training. Please submit your official military transcripts prior to starting classes.

Federal VA Education Benefits

Use this section if you are applying for Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33), Veteran Readiness and Employment (Ch 31)(formerly Vocational Rehabilitation), Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (Ch 30), Montgomery GI Bill Selected Reserve (Ch 1606), or Survivors & Dependents Assistance (Ch 35). Transfer Student - Previously Used Federal VA Education Benefits at Another College

- Submit [VA-Education Benefit Request Form](#) (VA-EBRF)
- Post 9/11 GI Bill (Ch 33) ONLY:** Certificate of Eligibility (COE) **OR** print off your Education Enrollment Status Entitlement Form online at: www.va.gov
- Official military transcripts (see side 1 of this form for more information)

Wisconsin GI Bill

- Submit [VA-Education Benefit Request Form](#) (VA-EBRF)
- Submit Application for the WI GI Bill ([WDVA 2029](#) form)
- Submit “Certification for WI GI Bill Benefits and Residency for Tuition Purposes” (WDVA 2031 form) to Gateway upon receipt from the WDVA
- Veteran’s [Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty](#) (DD-214)
- Official-military transcripts (see side 1 for more information)

Spouse or Dependent of a Veteran – Needs to Apply for the Wisconsin GI Bill

- Submit to the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA)** - Application for the WI GI Bill (WDVA 2030 form) by going to: <https://applications.dva.wisconsin.gov/myWisVets>
- Submit [VA-Education Benefit Request Form](#) (VA-EBRF)
- Application for Wisconsin G.I. Bill ([WDVA 2029](#) Form)
- Submit “Certification for Wisconsin GI Bill Benefits and Residency for Tuition Purposes” (WDVA 2031 form) to Gateway upon receipt from WDVA
- Veteran’s [Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty](#) (DD-214)
- Birth Certificate (dependent of a Veteran)
- Marriage Certificate (spouse of a Veteran)
- Copy of government issued photo ID (spouse of a veteran)
- Copy of most recently filed Federal Tax Return (unremarried surviving spouse of a veteran)
