## Total Credits and GPA Graduation Requirements

A total of 120 credits is required to graduate with any Bachelor's Degree (B.A. or B.S.), with the last 36 credits for the degree earned at UW-Parkside as outlined in university policy. All UW-Parkside graduates must have a minimum overall GPA requirement of 2.00 in order to graduate from UW-Parkside. Graphic Design majors must have a minimum 2.75 in all UW-Parkside Art Department courses in order to graduate with a degree in Graphic Design or a 2.5 minimum GPA in all Art Department courses to graduate with a "generalist" Art degree. All minimum GPA requirements for completing Art degrees at UW-Parkside will be strictly enforced.
