Introduction and Rationale:

The University of Wisconsin-Superior maintains an educational partnership with the Colleges of the Wisconsin Technical System (WTCS colleges) to provide opportunities for students to enter bachelor's degree completion programs. In the interest of fostering cooperation between our institutions and to better serve the transfer of students from WTCS colleges to the University of Wisconsin-Superior, the faculty and administration of our institutions have established this articulation agreement.

This Agreement specifies the transfer of credit from the WTCS Associate of Applied Science Degree named above to the UWS Bachelor's Degree named above in recognition that the WTCS program prepares students for admission to this Bachelor's Degree program. The underlying assumption for such agreement is that the technical college provides a foundation of coursework and the university provides the upper-level courses required within the Bachelor's Degree program.

WTCS students who successfully complete the Associate of Applied Science Degree named above and wishing to transfer to the University of Wisconsin-Superior Elementary Education Program with their minors in Instruction and Early Childhood Education will be awarded the following credits toward a B.S. Degree in Elementary Education with Instruction and Early Childhood Minors.

Requirements

Admission to UW-Superior: Students from WTCS must have completed the above-named program with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 for consideration for transfer to UW-Superior under the terms of this document. Admission to the Teacher Education program requires a 2.75/4.0.

Admissions to Teacher Education: Admissions to UW-Superior does not guarantee admissions to the Teacher Education Program/Elementary Education Major (ELED). Students must pass a Criminal Background Check and provide a recent documentation of a negative tuberculosis test. Students must also achieve an honors grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 in all of their collegiate coursework. For more information see the most up-to-date UW-Superior Catalog: Admissions to Teacher Education.

University Studies: WTCS General Education/breadth courses in social sciences, communications, mathematics, writing, and natural science may transfer in to fulfill some of UW-Superior's 42 University Studies requirements. All University Studies requirements not met by transfer credits must be completed for graduation.

Major Credits: 42 credits are required to complete the Elementary Education Major.

Minor Credits: An Instruction Minor of at least 22 credits must be completed with this Major. An additional Minor in Early Childhood Education is available. The Early Childhood Education Program at WTCS (39 credits) transfers in as 18 credits and requires 3 more credits specifically from ECED to complete the UWS ECED Minor.

Electives: Elective WTCS courses not listed above will be reviewed with the UW System Transfer Information System or by the UW-Superior faculty on a case by case basis.

Advising: The UW-Superior and the WTCS colleges will provide academic advising to WTCS college learners inquiring about UW-Superior's programs. Learners will be connected with a UW-Superior advisor prior to transfer. UW-Superior and WTCS colleges will share materials, catalogs, and other information to facilitate the understanding of requirements and programs. WTCS colleges will assist UW-Superior in arranging recruitment events on its campuses.

Program Completion: Students are required to complete a final project (in the case of Elementary Education, this is 12 credits of appropriate student teaching full time for 18 weeks in the schools) to be eligible for the ELED degree. Students must have a GPA of 2.75/4.0 to move into Student Teaching. The Wisconsin DPI requires that students pass appropriate Praxis content knowledge exams and the WI Foundation of Reading Test before Student Teaching.

General Degree Requirements: In order to be awarded a degree from UW-Superior, students are required to earn:

- 120 total credits to complete the bachelor's degree named above,
- at least 30 credits at UW-Superior,
- at least 36 credits in upper-division courses (300-400 level), and
- their final 12 credits through UW-Superior.

Marketing: Any marketing of this agreement will be subject to the prior approval of UW-Superior and the WTCS colleges and will adhere to each institutions standards for the use of its name and logo. Each

institution will assume responsibility for appropriate marketing to reach its student population. Each institution may provide a link to this agreement and/or the other institution(s) on its website, with notice to the other party.

Conditions:

The terms of this articulation agreement apply only for the purposes of entry to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education at the University of Wisconsin-Superior. WTCS students seeking admission to other degree programs offered at UW-Superior may transfer to the University only those credits recognized under the current UW System-Transfer Guidelines as documented on the Transferology website https://www.transferology.com/index.htm.

This Agreement is limited to UW-Superior's requirements for completion of a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education only and reflects current catalog and Wisconsin licensure requirements. The state licensure requirements can change due to state or federal legislation at any time. Students seeking certification for licensure in Elementary Education and Early Childhood Education must complete any additional requirements for such certification and those requirements supersede the requirements in this articulation.
